

The program consists of 3 components:

- 2 hours of didactic (classroom) teaching with a half hour of co-teaching directly from an individual with I/DD
- 2 hours of experiential learning – visiting a local family who cares for an adult with I/DD at home
- An on-line self-reflection assignment (in a forum where the students share their essays and access resources and instructor feedback)
